15. Students must show respect to the staff members and their seniors.

16. The school is not responsible for any damages/charges whatsoever, for any injuries, fatal or otherwise, caused during the student's stay in the school, even if these take place within or outside the school campus, while out on camps/picnics/educational tours or while taking part in sports/games or any other form of activity of the school.
17. It is the duty and right of the parents to make suggestions/complaints for which a register is maintained in the school office.

## SYSTEM OF EXAMINATION

1. Regular periodical tests will be held in addition to the August December and March Terminal Exams . Promotion will depend on these tests and examinations. Children of K.G. to class V will have regular weekly tests.
2. No re-examination and those absent without genuine reason will be deemed as failed. In case of illness, a medical certificate issued by a competent authority is must.
3. No candidate will be admitted to any of the examinations unless all school dues have been paid in full.
4. Wilful breaking of any of the regulations for the conduct of examination is punishable with expulsion or cancellation of the paper.
5. Promotion to higher class depend upon:
  - a) Regularity in attendance (at least 80%).
  - b) Regularity and quality of day-to-day participation in the class.
  - c) Opinion of teachers concerned.
  - d) Written work and projects assigned by the subject teachers.
  - e) A student failing twice in the same class will have to discontinue her/his studies at the school.
